The railway and bus companies included in the agreement for the referenced countries include:

- **VIA Rail Canada** with trains departing from Montreal, Toronto, and Vancouver to 13 destinations through Canada, such as Gaspe, Halifax, Jasper, Niagara Falls, Quebec, and Winnipeg, among others.
- **Renfe in Spain** with train services from Madrid Atocha and Chamartin and connections to 31 destinations, such as Barcelona, Bilbao, Granada, Leon, Malaga, Murcia, Sevilla and Valencia, among others.
- **First Great Western in the United Kingdom** offering train services from the London Paddington station to 11 cities across the country, such as Cotswolds, English Riviera, Exeter, Isles of Scilly, and Oxford, among others. In **London**, the agreement also includes **National Express**

bus services from the Central Bus Station to 29 destinations, such as Birmingham, Cambridge, Cheltenham Spa, Nottingham, Oxford, and Southampton, among others.
