Frontier Airlines will launch new service in Colorado Springs, Columbus, Pittsburgh and San Antonio starting in April, May and June as well as expand service from its largest market in Denver. Frontier is offering special introductory fares as low as \$19 one-way on these new routes as of today at Flyfrontier.com. With The WORKSsm, fares will be as low as \$112.

Five new cities from Pittsburgh

Frontier will add non-stop service between Pittsburgh and Atlanta, Chicago O'Hare, Denver, Las Vegas and Orlando. Flights to Denver will operate daily while flights to Chicago will operate on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays. Flights to the other cities will operate on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays. Fares in these new markets will be as low as \$19.

Four new cities from San Antonio
