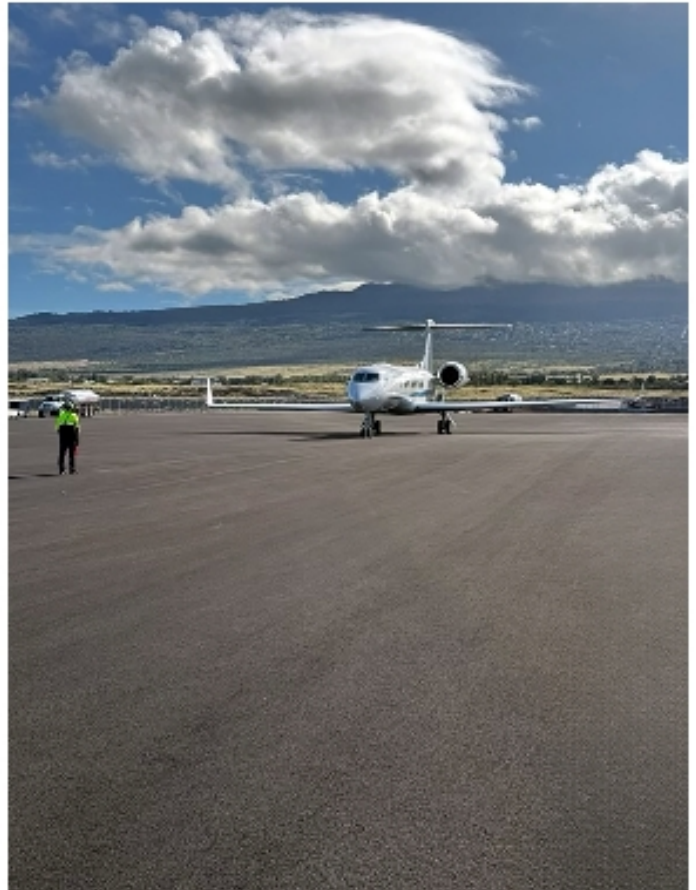




BIG ISLAND JET CENTER CELEBRATES ONE MILLION GALLONS OF FUEL SOLD

Big Island Jet Center is excited to announce a major milestone in its operations as it sold its one millionth gallon of fuel this July. The impressive achievement comes within a mere seven months of the FBO's grand opening and before the completion of its permanent terminal, slated to be finished in Q3 2025. Hawaii's newest premier FBO, located at Kailua-Kona's Ellison Onizuka Kona International Airport (PHKO), celebrated its grand opening in December 2023 as a start-up on the field, first welcoming passengers just in time for the busy holiday season. As the only independent FBO with exclusive parking, BIJC is currently booking its last few parking opportunities for the 2024 holiday season.

Tom Owen, general manager of Big Island Jet Center commented: "We are incredibly proud of this accomplishment, especially in such a short amount of time. Our temporary facility has been incredibly well-received, and we are excited about what the future will bring.
