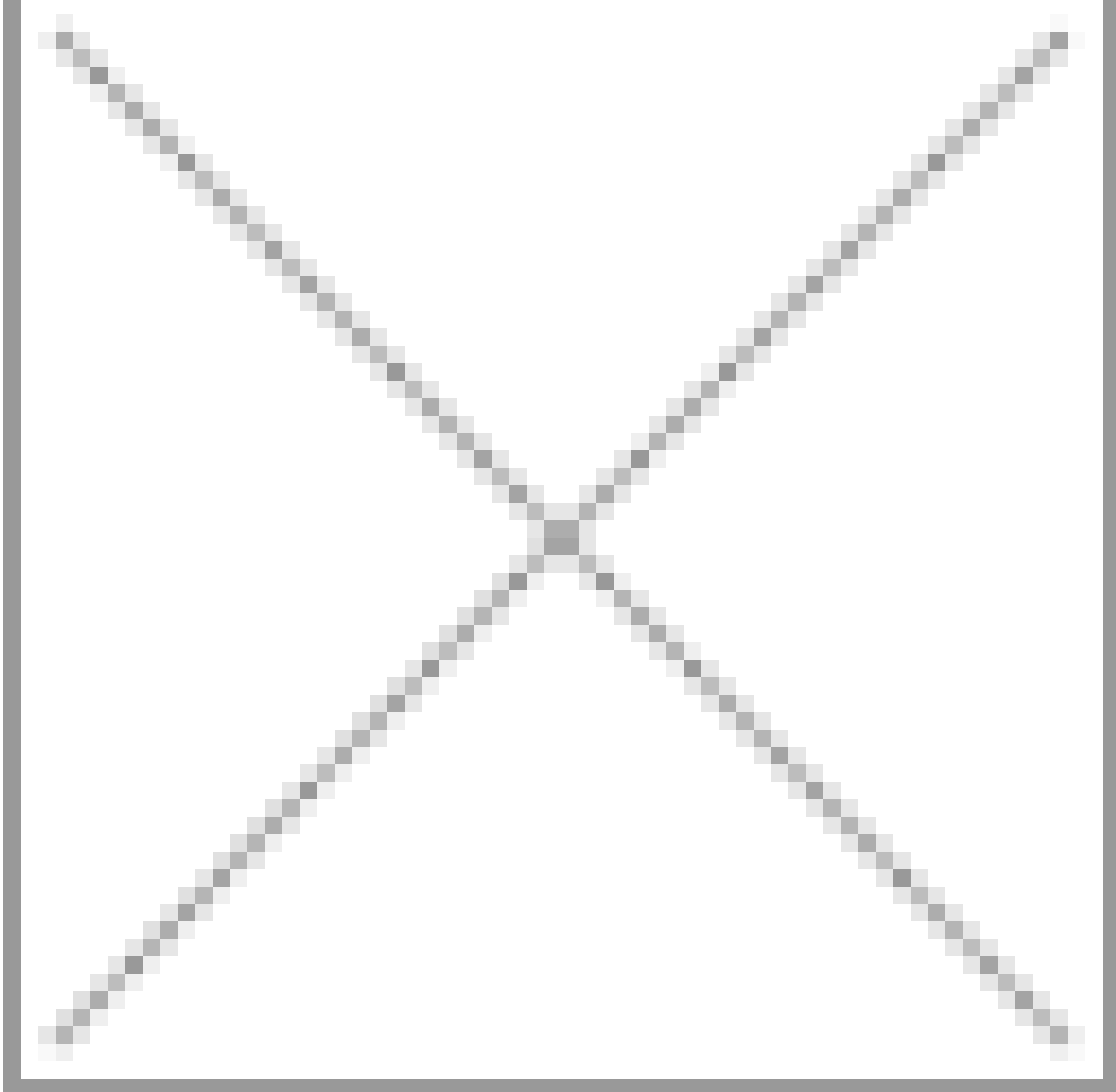


Boutsen Aviation Founders Thierry and Daniela Boutsen were awarded the Special Jury Prize at the 5th Annual “Trophées de l’Eco” at the Grimaldi Forum in Monaco. Hosted by the Monaco Economic Board, six entrepreneurs were awarded prizes based on their contributions to the Principality. There is little doubt that Boutsen Aviation has greatly contributed to the entrepreneurial spirit of Monaco: Over the past nineteen years, the team has sold 329 aircraft around the world and holds the official title of “By Appointment to HSH Prince Albert II”.

The entire team of Boutsen Aviation Monaco was present at the ceremony to support Thierry and Daniela Boutsen as they took the stage to accept the first award of the evening. It was presented by Christian Pinault of Caisse d’Epargne Côte D’Azur and Michel Prost Dumont of BP Méditerranée.
