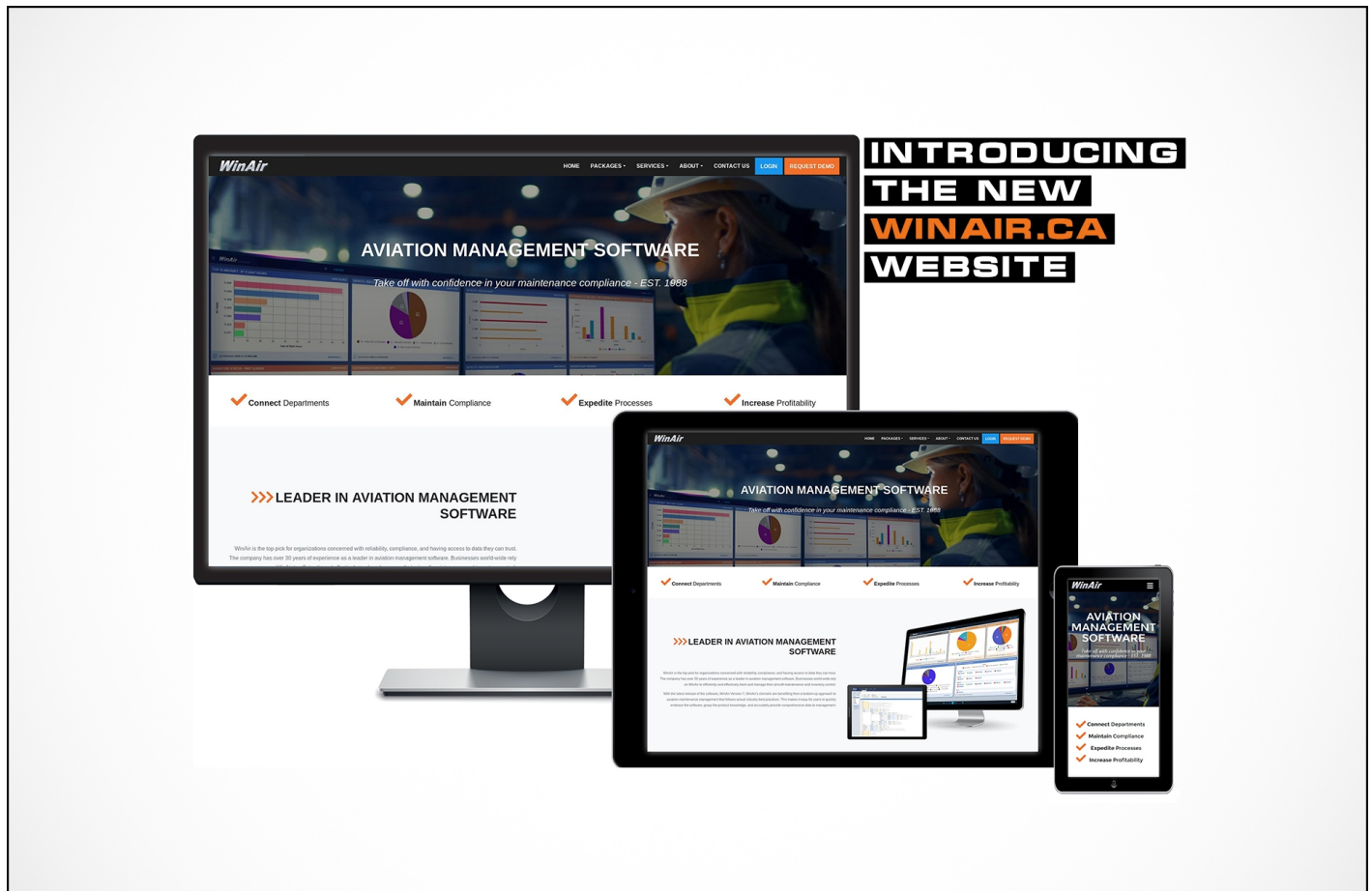


NEW WEBSITE FOR OPERATORS, HELIOPS, MROS, AND CAMOS LAUNCHED BY WINAIR
