Passengers will have a seamless transition from the welcome desk through the FBO to the executive VIP lounge, which includes modern comfort facilities, complimentary refreshments and new private business centre, as well as pilot and crew lounge.



It also incorporates state-of-the-art conference facilities for up to 14 delegates, with projector and telecoms facilities, as well as uninterrupted panoramic views across the airfield and for miles into the Cambridgeshire countryside.
