



FL TECHNICS TRAINING INTRODUCES EXAMINATION OPTION TO ITS ONLINE TRAINING™ PLATFORM

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FL Technics Training, a global provider of aviation technical [training](#) services, is delighted to announce that its EASA-compliant Online Training™ platform has further expanded its functionality. From now on, having completed a training course, the company's corporate and individual customers will be able to take an online exam before actually receiving the certificate. The new feature is currently available for Fuel Tank Safety (Phase 2) course.

Upon the completion of courses with the new functionality, students are presented with the opportunity to pass the examination online. This feature can be accessed by simply pushing the button “Start”. The bottom line for passing is 75%, so if a student does not succeed at the first attempt, he or she can have another go at it 24 hours later. Upon the successful passing of the exam within the two attempts, students will be issued the required certificates, while failing both times will result in an automatic requirement to re-purchase the course. Having launched the first course with the option of examination, the company is planning to supplement its platform with two additional courses (Human Factors based on Part 145 and Fuel Tank Safety (Phase 1)) within a few months.
