



JET AVIATION RECEIVES PHILIPPINES' CAA APPROVAL FOR BASEL MAINTENANCE FACILITY

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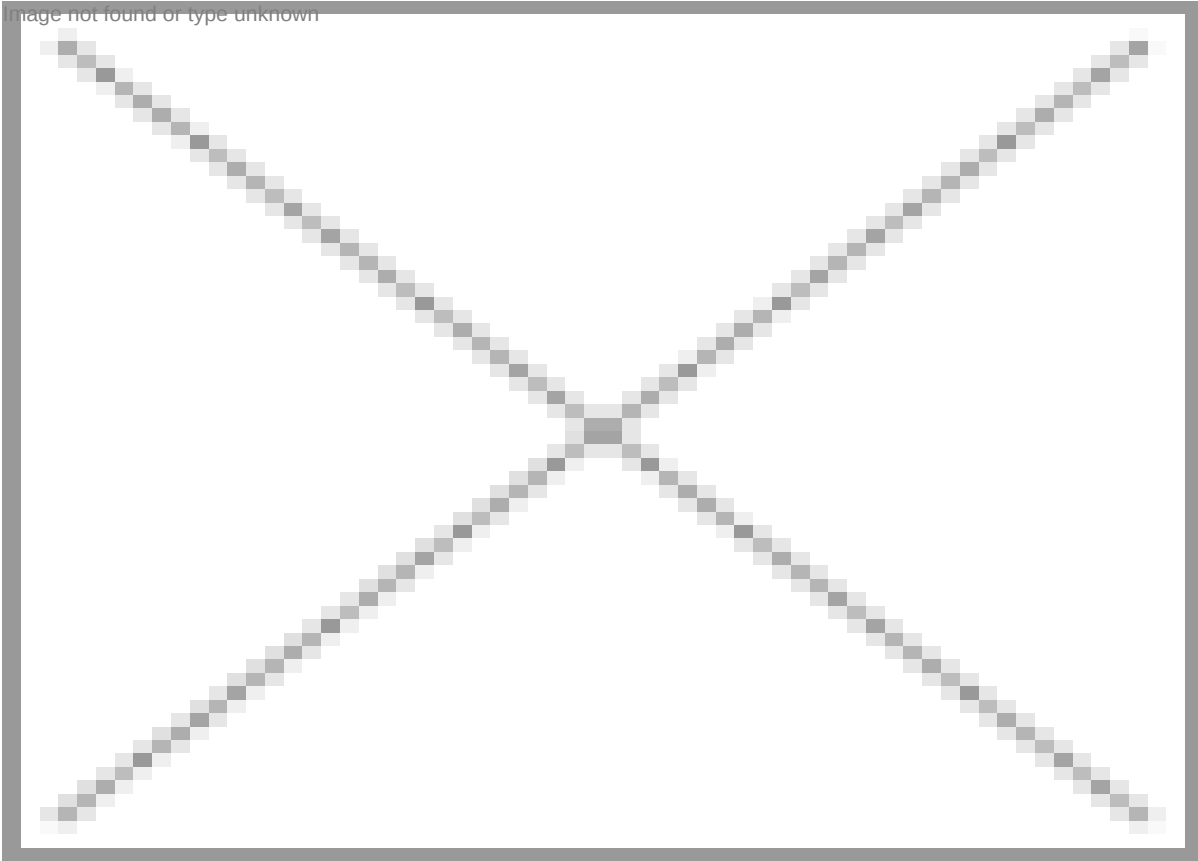
