



LUFTHANSA TECHNIK SIGNS MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT FOR MAS AIRCRAFT

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Lufthansa Technik and the Mexican carrier mas - formerly known as MasAir- have signed a comprehensive Total Component Support (TCS®) contract covering repair and overhaul of components for mas's Airbus A330F fleet. The new contract governs supply for up to eight aircraft over a period of eight years. This is the second contract as Lufthansa Technik already supports the Boeing 767F fleet with its TCS product.

Luis Sierra, Chief Executive Officer of mas, said: "Our new A330 logistic network is a global network with destinations in Asia, Europe and America. To support our network, we need a global player in technical aircraft services whose experience and reliability we highly value. With the A330F Total Component Support TCS® agreement, mas benefits from an individual supply concept that enables short and rapid transport paths. Component support of mas fleet will

be ensured through an on-site stock to be established in Mexico City. The fleet will be supported by Lufthansa Technik's component pools located in North America and Europe.

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
