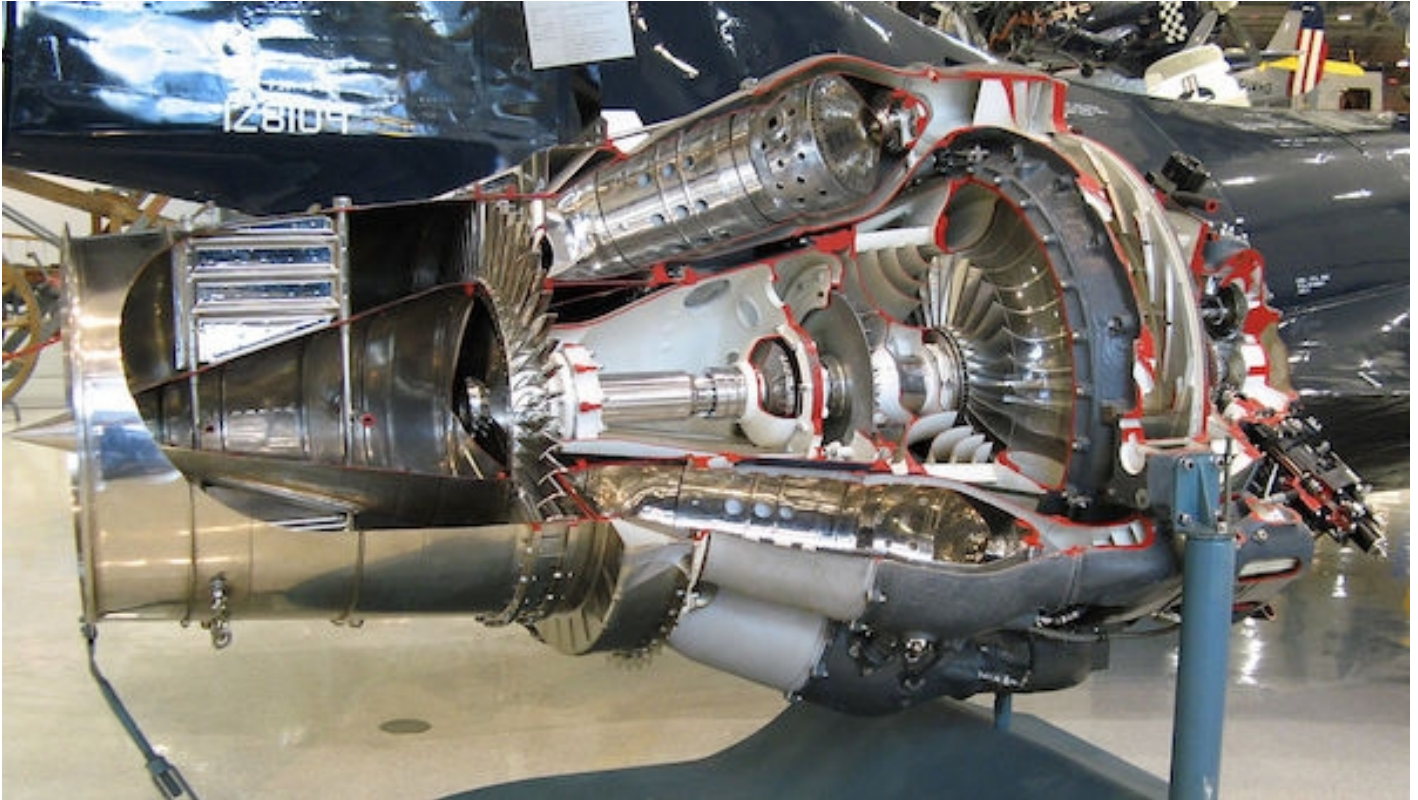




NEW PRATT & WHITNEY DESIGNATED MAINTENANCE FACILITIES ON FOUR CONTINENTS

Finally in Asia, AVIC China Flying Dragon GA will join COHC Aviation Science and Technic Co. Ltd in China for PT6A and PT6C engines and Taj Air Ltd in India for PW308C engines and Helicopter Services Company, JSC in Moscow, Russia for PW207K engine support.
