



SG AÉRO ACQUIRES AN ALSIM AL250 SIMULATOR

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SG Aéro based at the Troyes LFQB airfield, France, has bought an ALSIM AL250 simulator. The AL250 simulator addresses initial phase training needs (PPL, CPL, IR/ME) and is SEP/MEP re-configurable simulator certified as an EASA FNPT II and TC Level 2 IPC. In addition, it offers both classic and glass cockpit for each flight model at the simple flick of a switch. This device has been extremely well received since its creation and more than 80 of these have already been installed and are in successful operation worldwide.

Stéphane Guelin, President, and Education Manager of SG Aero, commented: "SG Aero wants to be a human scale school to remain the closest possible to the needs of its trainees.
