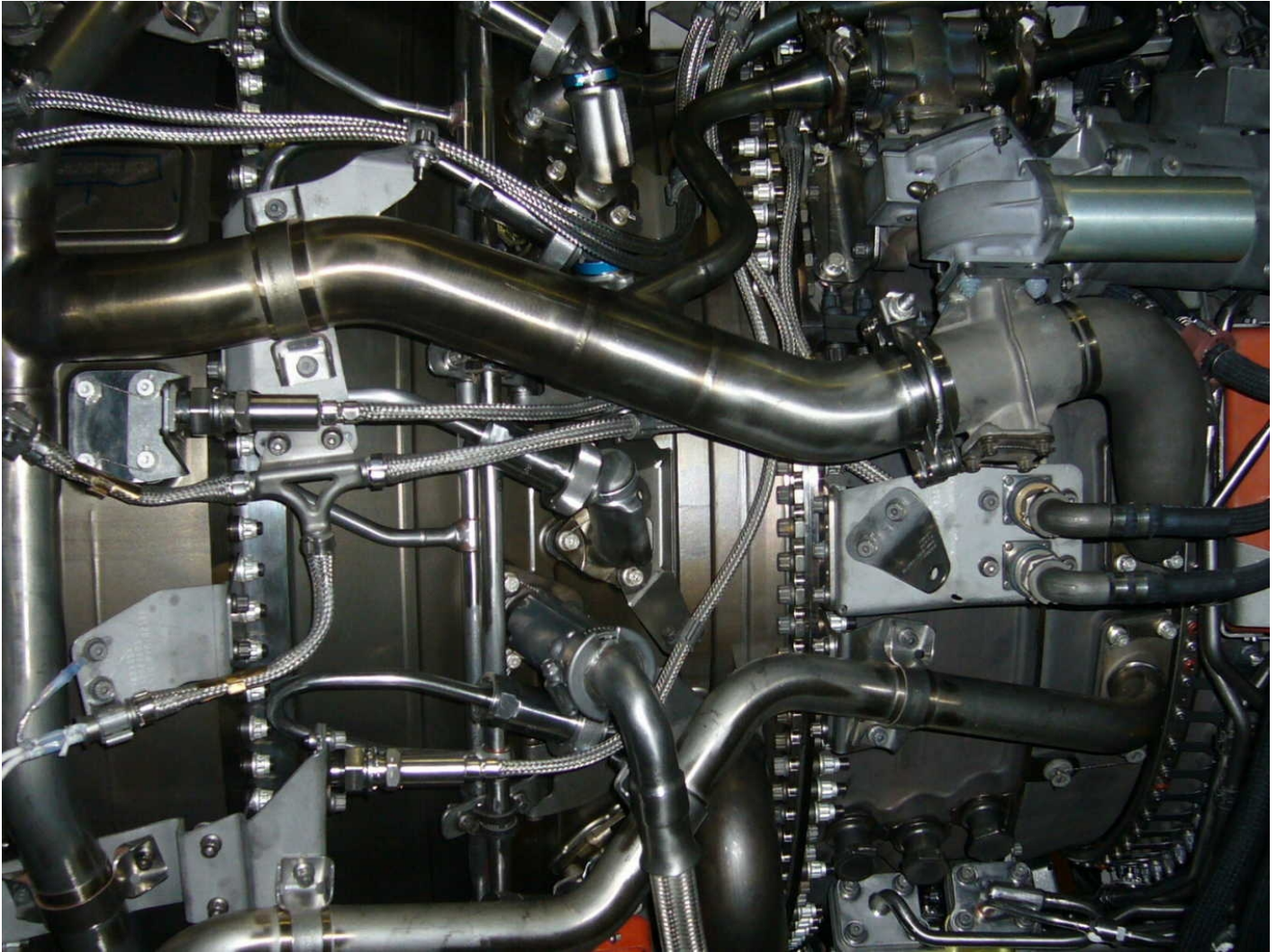




SR TECHNICS TO COOPERATE WITH S7 ENGINEERING
