Inselflieger, the region's largest provider of air services, transports approximately just over 70,000 passengers annually between the German mainland and the East Frisian Islands. The challenging short runways of these island destinations require exceptional STOL capabilities and the P2012 STOL has proven to be the ideal, innovative, modern response to this challenging environment.
